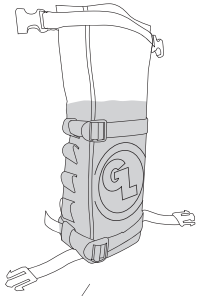
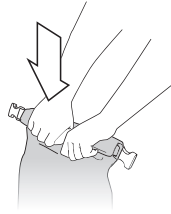


FENDER BAG INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

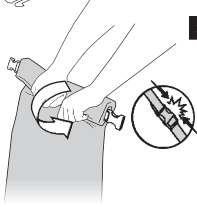
GETTING A GOOD TRIPLE ROLL IS CRITICAL TO A GOOD WATERPROOF SEAL.



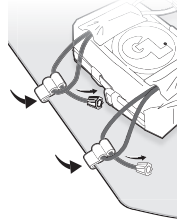
- 1** Leave ample room to allow for at least three rolls to seal.



- 2** Before rolling, push top down to squeeze air from bag. Roll at least three times.



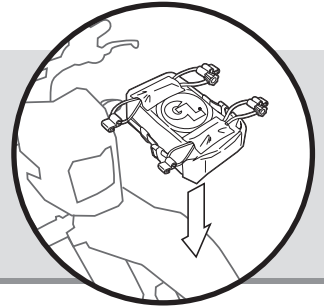
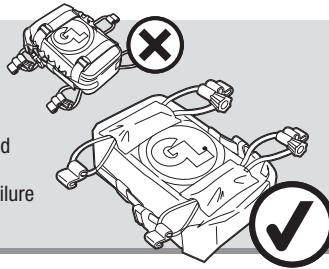
- 3** Holding the rolled ends tight, connect the buckles and cinch straps tightly.



- 4** Attach hooks to side of fender or number plate on both sides, pull tension cord snug and lock cord into the hook's slot. For extra security, add a backup tether cord to daisy chain and tie to the fork tube.

IMPORTANT: Welded Sleeves UP

Your Giant Loop Fender Bag is designed to be secured with the welded sleeves **FACING UP** with straps running over the top. This compresses and stabilizes the Fender Bag, taking stress off the welded sleeves, ensuring a long life. Securing your Fender Bag improperly can result in failure of the welded sleeves, particularly on rugged terrain.



PACKING TIPS

- For 100% waterproof protection, roll the top a minimum of 3 rolls.
- Do not overstuff or over-load Fender Bag. The challenge should be to pack as little as necessary to be safe, comfortable and self-sufficient. Go light. Go fast. Go far.
- Pack all sharp and/or hard items inside a protective layer. For example, create a sleeve for tire irons from a section of old inner tube, pack tools in rolls and wrap other hard items in clothing.

CARING FOR YOUR FENDER BAG™

- Keep away from hot exhaust.
- Avoid sharp metal edges. Protect webbing with inner tube sleeve to prevent abrasion.
- Secure loose webbing ends when riding. Check and retighten all connections at each stop.
- Avoid exposure to insect repellents containing DEET.
- Hand wash Fender Bag with mild soap (like Simple Green), rinse with clean water and air dry. **DO NOT MACHINE WASH OR DRY.**
- Prevent mold, mildew and funky stench by unpacking wet gear, rinsing thoroughly with fresh water and airing dry.
